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

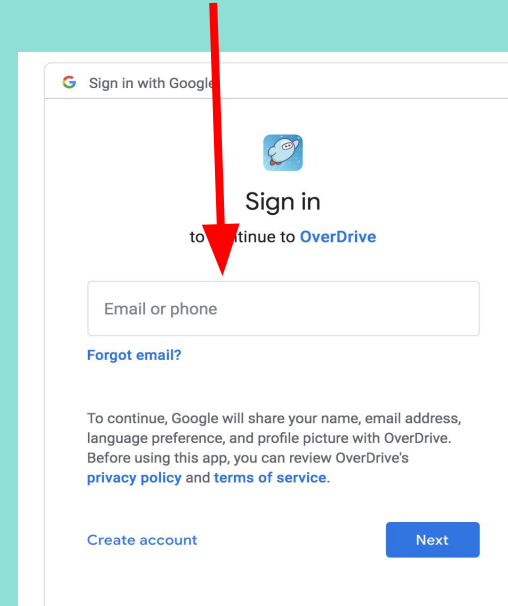

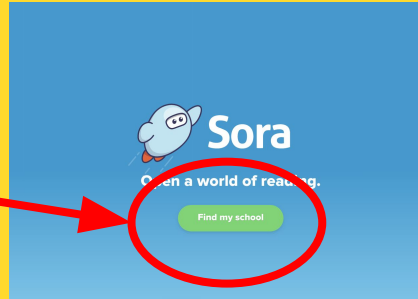
1. Click "Sign in using Fremont Union High School District"



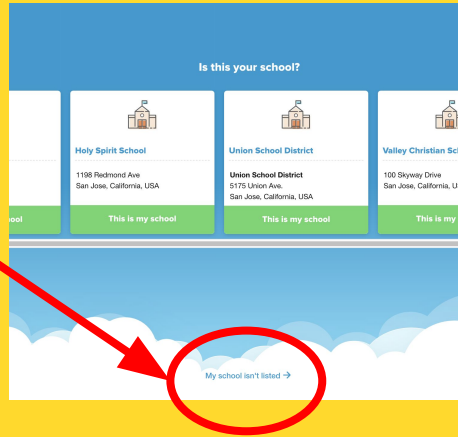

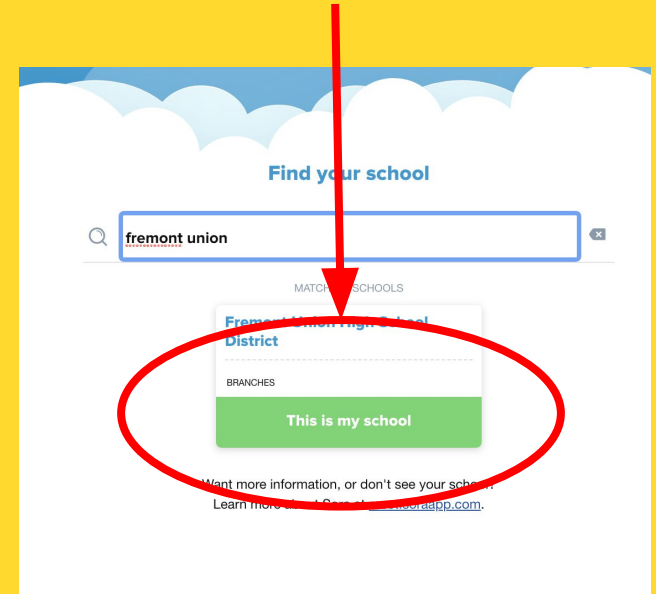
1. Click "Find my school"



2. Click "My school isn't listed"



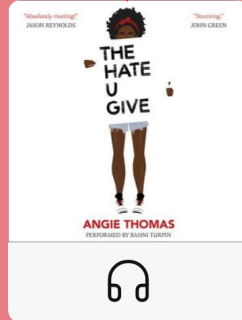
3. Type "Fremont Union High School District" then "This is my school"

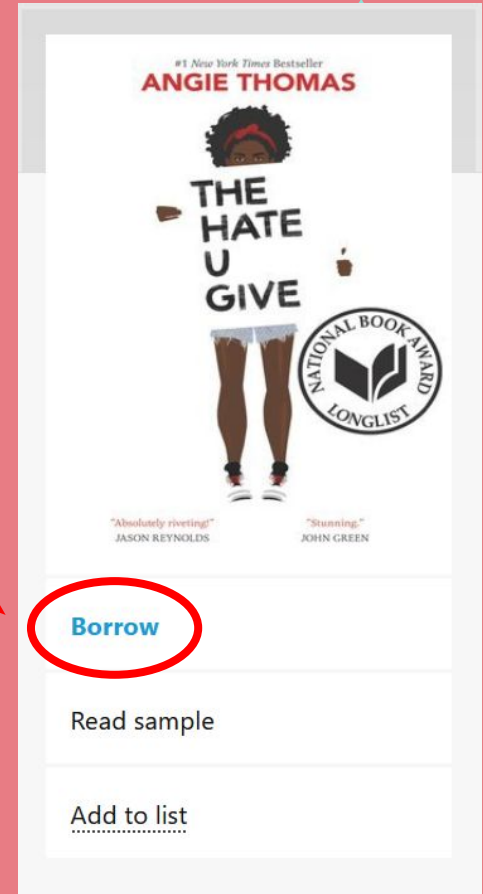

Go to  to see all your books.

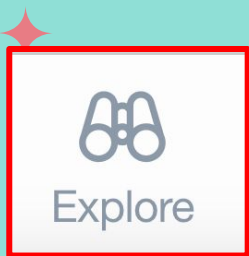
From there, you can:

*If you're on Wi-Fi, books automatically download for offline use. If you're using mobile data, you can stream books until you're on Wi-Fi.

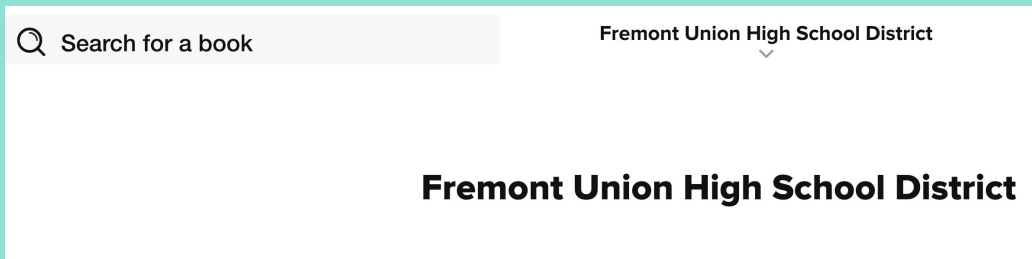

When you borrow a book, sign in with your eLibrary account.

- Your “Card Number” is your 7 digit ID number with an S in the front and FUHSD at the end.
- Your PIN is your birth month and birth day. See examples below:

How to return a book

Books are automatically returned on their due date.

If you finish a book early, you can return it before it's due date with these steps:

1. Go to  .
2. Select **Loans**.
3. Select **Options**.
4. Select **Return**, then select **Return** again.

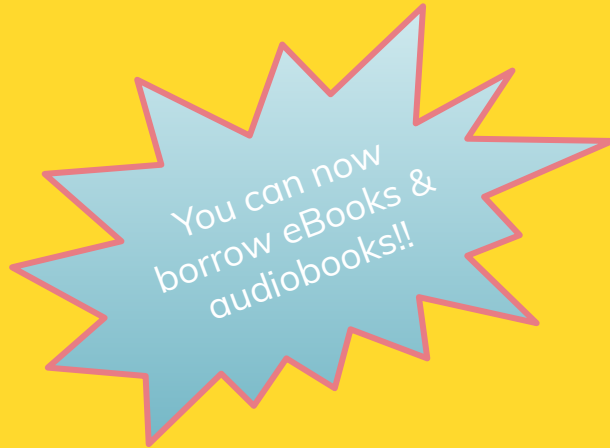
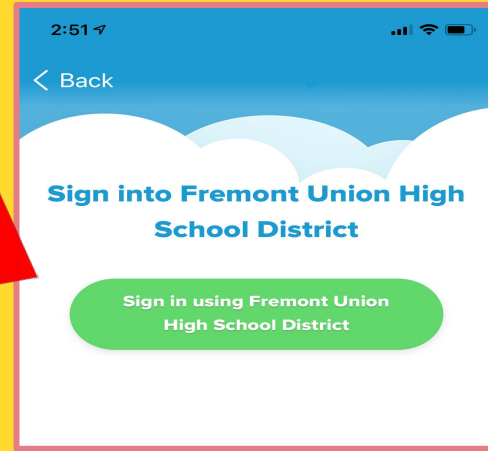
Get Sora on your phone.

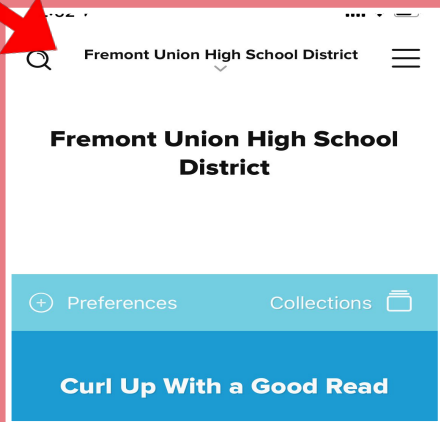

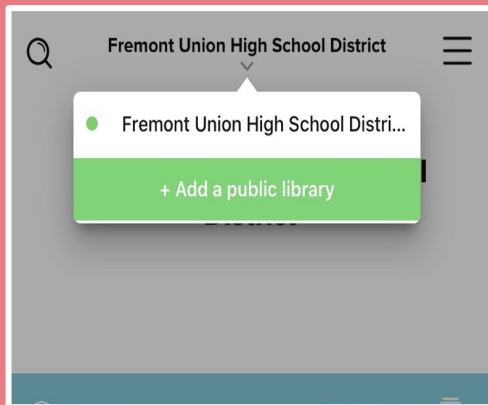

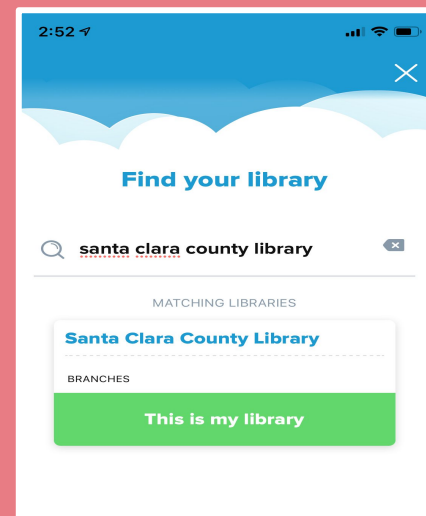
